Movement flood response

Fact sheet no. 16 3 March 2011

The following factsheet provides an overview of the assistance provided to flood-affected people up to 17 February by the Pakistan Red Crescent Society (PRCS) with the support of its Red Cross Red Crescent Movement (Movement) partners. The information presented is based on the reports shared by all partners and is compiled to present the overall achievements according to each sector.

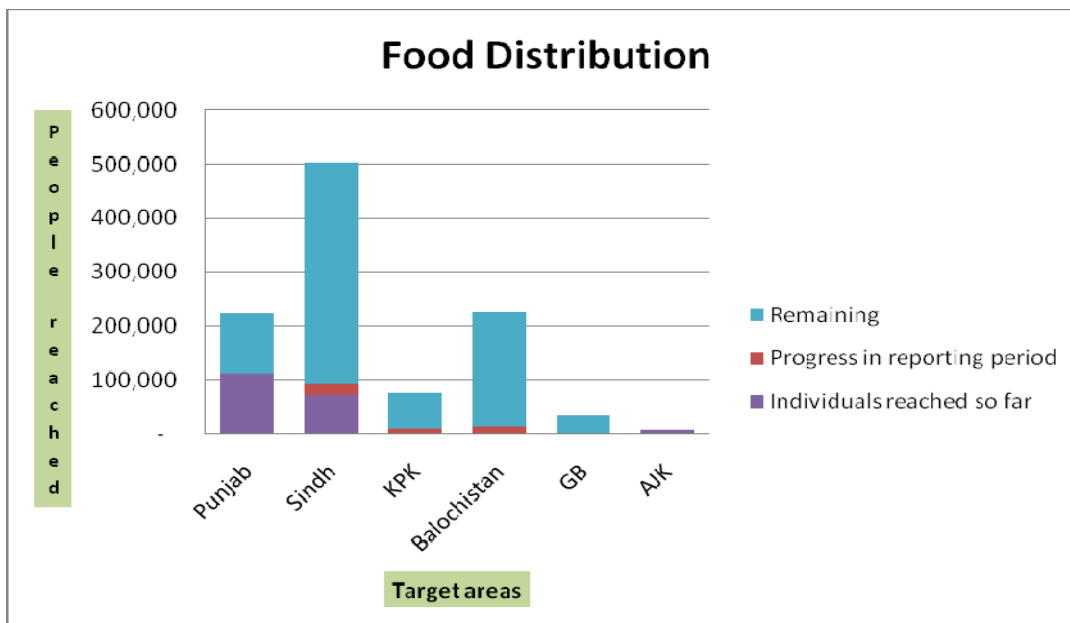
Highlights

As of 17 February:

- **2,636,389 people** have received food and non-food items through **relief** distributions.
- **207,526 people** have been reached with **health services** and **psychosocial support**.
- **684,783** have benefited from **water and sanitation** services.
- **Winterized transitional shelter** distribution in KPK, as part of early recovery, reaching **63,021 people**.
- The Movement continues **early recovery interventions**. **421,260 people** received agricultural assistance material in KPK, Sindh and Balochistan.

Relief

- The Red Cross Red Crescent Movement has reached **2,397,465 people** with food and **1,552,068 people** with non-food items, reaching its initial targets.
- In FATA and KPK, the Movement has completed relief distributions. Based on further needs transitioning into recovery, more food distribution is planned for Balochistan, KPK, Gilgit Baltistan, AJK, Punjab and Sindh, with **238,924 people** already reached. The following graph gives an overview of people reached so far with food distributions:

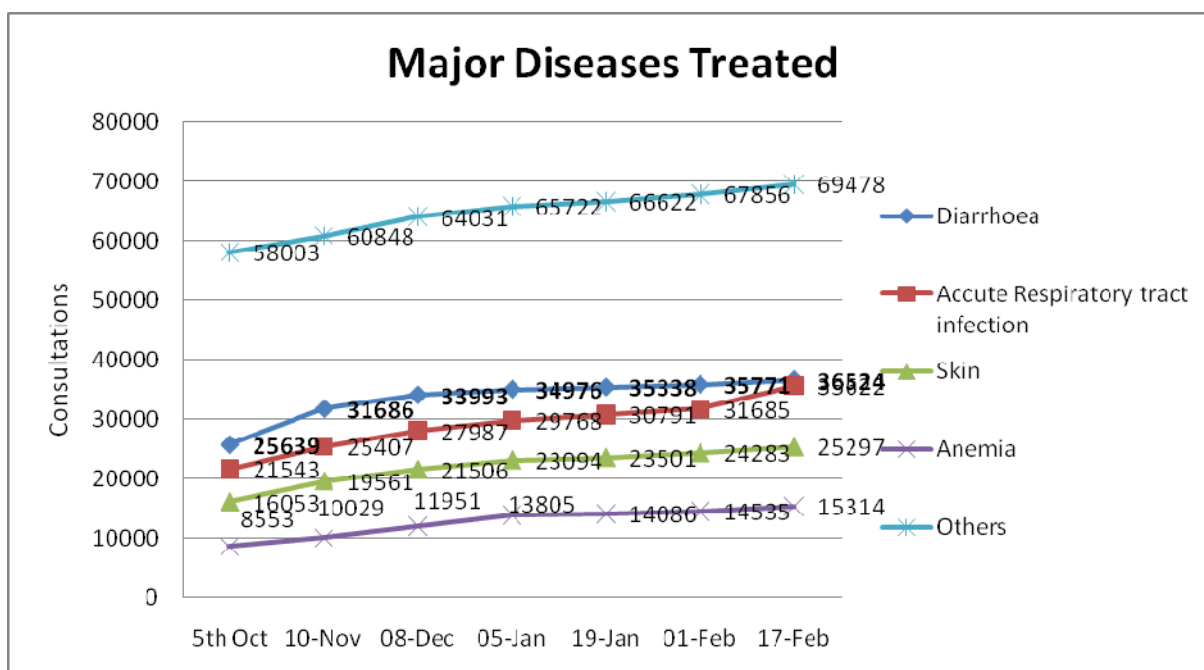


Shelter

- **358,465** tarpaulins, **25,483** tents and **66,882** shelter kits have been distributed under the non-food items relief distribution. This will cater for emergency shelter needs of the flood-affected people.
- The Movement's winterized shelter distribution is nearly completed in KPK. So far **63021** people have been reached.

Health

- The Red Cross Red Crescent Movement is providing emergency and basic health services through **8 health teams** in flood-affected areas¹. A total of **185,689** people have been reached in all the flood-affected areas.



Psychosocial support programme (PSP)²

- In total **21,837** people have been reached – these continue receiving ongoing PSP support, especially in Sindh where needs are greatest.
- PSP activities include informal education, group sessions on psychosocial education, sports activities, referrals, individual sessions and dealing with the vulnerable.

Water and sanitation³

- Since the start of the operation, **75,236,726** litres of water have been produced. To date, water and sanitation services have benefitted **684,783** people. The table below gives an overview of water and sanitation interventions.

¹ There were 33 health teams and 4 diarrhoea treatment centres at the height of the operation. During the reporting period another health team stopped working in KPK, bringing the number of health teams working in field to 8.

² Ongoing PSP activities are sustained for the same target populations. Reporting figures are expected to rise as early recovery identifies further populations in need of PSP.

³ With return movements of flood affected people, most of the Movement's water and sanitation response has been completed for the relief phase.

Restoring Family Links (RFL)⁴

- For relatives separated by floods, often displaced, the Red Cross Red Crescent Movement set up an emergency phone service to restore family links benefiting 879 families. At least **6,200 people** have been served.

Early Recovery

- The Red Cross Red Crescent Movement has completed seed, fertilizers and tool kits distributions reaching **421260** people in KPK, Sindh and Baluchistan to assist flood affected people whose livelihoods/crops and homes were damaged in the floods. The assistance is meant to help the flood affected people to re-cultivate their agricultural lands for the ongoing *Rabi* season.
- A total of **407,260 people** have been assisted with provision of seeds, fertilizers and tool kits in KPK and Balochistan.
- A total of **14,000 people** have been reached with provision of winter vegetables seeds in Sindh.
