

# ***INDONESIA: LANDSLIDE***

*8 January 1999*

## ***Information Bulletin N° 01***

### ***The Disaster***

Yesterday morning (Thursday, 7 January) around 08:00 hours, a landslide occurred in the village of Timbul, Tegallalang sub-district, Gianyar district, approximately 35 km north of Denpasar in Bali.

According to a casualty report received from the Indonesian Red Cross (PMI) Bali Chapter, 17 people were killed, two people were seriously injured and two people lightly injured. A further 30 people are still missing. According to an Associated Press report, hundreds of villagers rushed to the site with hoes and other farm tools to dig for survivors.

### ***Red Cross/Red Crescent Action***

The PMI mobile emergency vehicle and a team of 11 PMI volunteers were sent to the location. They are working together with locally stationed soldiers and other volunteers to rescue the missing people.

### ***Needs***

According to information received to date, the operation is within the local capacity. However, further operational progress reports from the PMI local branch and provincial chapter are expected.
