# BISHKEK DECLARATION

## **The Bishkek Declaration**

is a document agreed on by youth delegates during the 23rd European Youth Cooperation Meeting in 2018 in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. Its three main topics and three enabling actions will guide the work of the EYN in the coming years.

# main topics

### Mental health and emotional

well-being Support volunteers and communities against depression, anxiety and other mental health challenges

### **Humanitarian Education and**

**Advocacy** Promote a culture of non-violence and peace in order to counter the rise of xenophobia and social exclusion

**Migration** Support the actions in the field of migration and focus on psychological support for migrants and volunteers

# enabling actions

**Youth Engagement** Facilitate and develop the participation of youth in decision-making processes

Strengthen EYN Facilitate and develop the networking actions to share knowledge and good practice between National Societies

Innovation in volunteering Identify new ways of recruiting and retaining volunteers to develop new innovative solutions in the field of volunteering
